Mark A. Hackel was born and raised in Macomb County and never missed a day of classes as a student. He holds an associate degree from Macomb Community College, a bachelor's degree from Wayne State University and a master's in public administration from Central Michigan University. Mark is also a graduate of the FBI National Academy and had the distinct honor of being selected as the #1 recruit from his class at the Macomb Regional Police Academy.

Mark's career in law enforcement began in 1981 as a dispatcher with the Macomb County Sheriff's Office. During his 30-year career, he worked his way through every rank and was ultimately elected sheriff. In November 2010, Mark was elected Macomb's first-ever county executive. In this position, he serves as a voice and an advocate for the county and works to make Macomb a great place to call home.
